Our Sailing Areas

Our yachts are berthed at the Royal Langkawi Yacht Club (RLYC) in Bass Harbour. Our main sailing area is round the Langkawi Archipelago which includes nights at anchor and in Marina's at Telaga and on Rebak Island. These waters give a good variety of day and night sailing experiences for all students from competent crew to yachtmaster.

A sample itinerary for a 5 day course in these waters would be:

Day 1: safety briefing, berthing experience, getting to know the yacht around Bass Harbour before setting sail for Telaga Marina (H) Night in Marina and supper ashore.

Day 2: Long sail around the top of the island with meal stops under anchor at bays (F) and (E) which offers plenty of experiences to improve sailing skills, techniques and passage planning. Night sail to Hole in the Wall (C) for a night at anchor.

Day 3: Wake in an amazing anchorage and spend time passage planning for a day sail back to Bass Harbour through the ferry channel at P. Timum with skills and drills and lunch and swim stops en route. Night in the RLYC marina and supper ashore.

Day 4: Skills and drills and berthing practice in and around the marina. Followed by passage planning by students to the anchorage at the back of Pulau Dayang, known locally as the Fiords.

Day 5: wake and swim in another beautiful anchorage then set off back to the RLYC with meal and swim stops at (U) and (V) Lots of opportunities on this last day sail to consolidate skills and drills, courses to steer, passage planning. Berthing practice at the RLYC. Clean the yacht and meet in Charles Bar to receive certificates and feedback before returning home.
